


What do you remember from today's reading?

Why did they see Jesus as special?




Jesus teaches the people through the stories he tells. But he also teaches them - and us - through the things he does. He lives out what he is teaching.

Can you think of an example when Jesus teaches us through his action What does he want us to learn?


Teachers are very important, they help us to learn about all sorts of things. What do your teachers do to help you to learn?

Some children who live in poorer countries around the world do not have the chance to go to school.


Can you think of reasons why that might be?





Do you think it is fair that these children do not have the chance to learn?




Every child has a right to go to school. The charity CAFOD works together with local people around the world to make sure more children can learn.




Faizah lives in a village in Sudan. Her school had no roof, so when it rained the pupils and teachers simply got wet. There were no seats and it was hard to get books and stationery.



But now, Faizah's school has been rebuilt. CAFOD worked with local experts to provide chairs, stationery, books, everything that the children and teachers need to learn and teach well.



Faizah says, "The school is beautiful. We're very proud of it. Now we have proper classrooms and chairs and it's less stressful and easier to learn."


