Look at my hands and my feet. It is I myself! Touch me and see; a ghost does not have flesh and bones, as you see I have.

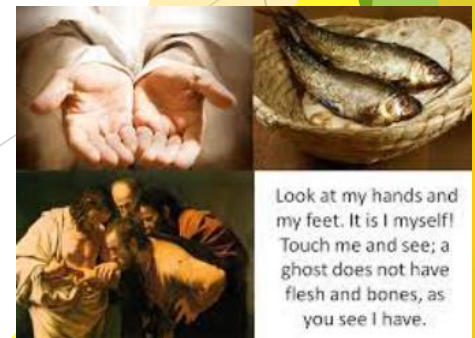
Jesus eats some fish.

Many of Jesus' first followers were fishermen and the first Christians used fish as a symbol that they followed Jesus.



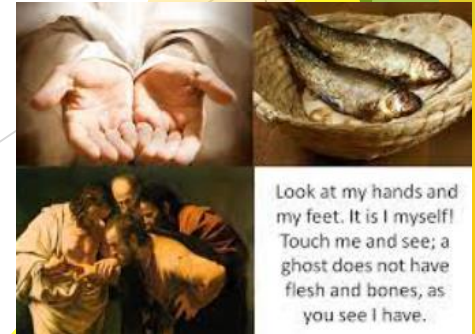

James is a fisherman in Liberia. Sometimes he has to go out in his boat during dangerous storms and sometimes it can be hard to find fish to catch. Like the disciples James trusts in God. He says, “God comes first and then fishing... I put my boat out to sea and I pray. I remind myself: ‘Seek and you will find. Knock and the door will open.’ Each time I pray, I remember this.”

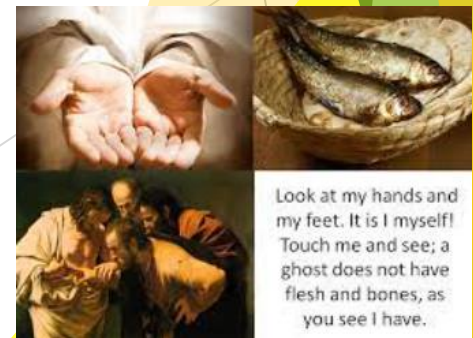
A special project has helped James with a life jacket and a fish finder, which means he can find good fishing spots and return home safely.

After eating, Jesus gives the disciples a special job to be his witnesses; to tell other people about his life, death and resurrection and his message of God's love and forgiveness.

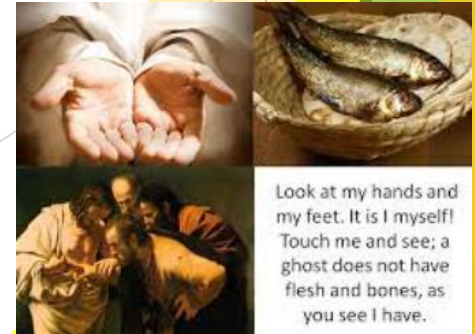
The Christian faith has been passed on person to person for more than 2,000 years. Who are the people who have told you the story of Jesus?

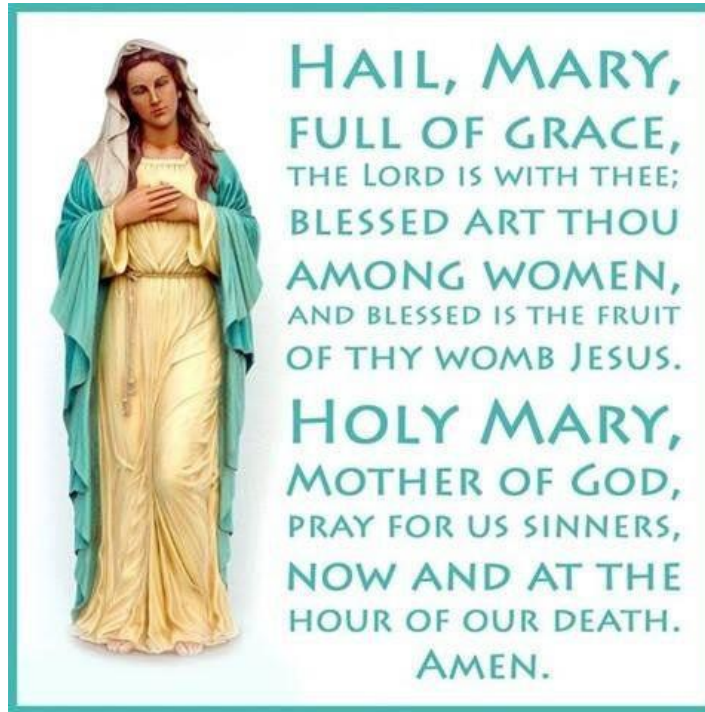

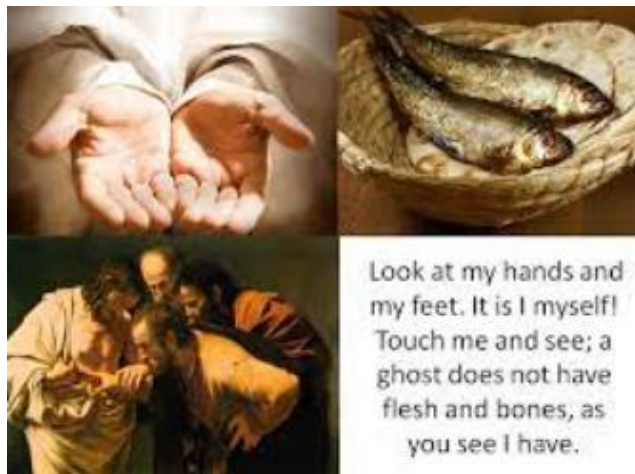
