




# We are still and silent as we reflect on God's word for us in the Gospel.





Why were they frightened?




Then a cloud came over and Jesus's friends heard a voice, saying "This is my Son, the Beloved. Listen to him."

On the mountain the disciples saw Jesus's true loving self, shining like the rays of the sun.


If we listen to Jesus and spend time with God in our hearts, then we too can let our true light shine brightly.

What sounds can you hear?




You can hear so much more when you really take time to listen. So how do you think we can best listen to what Jesus has to say to us in our lives?

We pray for all people who are poor: that they may have the chance to change their lives for the better.


