# \*\*New\*\* The Holy Father's homily for the Feast of the Guardian Angels and the Opening of the Second Session of the Synod

"Brothers and sisters, we begin anew our synodal path with an eye toward the world, since the Christian community is always at the service of humanity in order to announce the joy of the Gospel. In such a dramatic time in our history, when the winds of war and the flames of violence continue to devastate entire peoples and nations, there is need for this message. In order to invoke the intercession of Mary Most Holy for the gift of peace, I will recite the holy rosary and make a heartfelt plea to the Virgin in the Basilica of Saint Mary Major this coming Sunday. If possible, I ask all members of the Synod to join me for this occasion. The following day, 7 October, I ask everyone to participate in a day of prayer and fasting for peace in the world. Let us walk together. Let us listen to the Lord and allow him to guide us by the "breath" of the Spirit."

The Holy Father asks that Monday 7<sup>th</sup> October, the memorial of Our Lady of the Rosary, to be a day of fasting and prayer for peace in the world. In addition, the Holy Father will recite the Holy Rosary on Sunday at the Basilica of Sta Maria Maggiore. It may be opportune to invite Parishioners to pray the rosary with him today invoking **Our Lady Queen of Peace**, and uniting their prayer with that of the Pope.

Please note that there will also be Rosary on Monday 7th October after Mass at Our Lady's and our October Devotions of 20 decades of the Rosary will continue on Thursday at the slightly earlier time of 4.45pm.
