
Praise to you Lord Jesus Christ

What do you remember from that reading?




People were bringing their children to Jesus for his blessing, but the disciples tried to stop them.

What did he say?




Jesus is angry and tells the disciples to let the children come to him.

How does it make you feel to know that Jesus thinks all children are important and that he wanted to listen to them?




Jesus welcomed and blessed the children who came to see him.

He loves us all.


No matter where in the world we live.

We know that Jesus welcomed children and so we have the courage to pray together:


We pray for the Church throughout the world: that it may be a place of welcome and support for all people, especially those who are poor.
