New Monday 25th November - 'Lament and Light' ecumenical service for the 16 days of activism against gender-based violence

An ecumenical service will be held on Monday 25th November at 2pm, at St Mary's Church in Plympton (Market Road, Plympton, Plymouth, PL7 1QW). The service is being held to mark the 16 days of activism against gender-based violence (25th November – 10th December), which is a campaign for the prevention and elimination of violence against women and girls. Fr Mark Skelton and Rev Lizzi Green will lead the service. Refreshments will be available afterwards.

New New Church Update

We have now finally been able to agree to appoint a local contractor from three who applied to begin on phase one of the conversion of the building. This will see work commencing in January with completion expected by the Summer and will include repairs where necessary, the new presbytery, parish office, vestry and ancillary rooms. All will be done to the highest standards of insulation and environmental protection, and we will be making good use of solar power.

Phase two will involve the church, sanctuary, narthex, confessional, baptistry, and sacristy, all designs of which are 95% complete. They will need approval by Bishop-Elect Philip before we can go out to tender. We already have expressions of interest from a number of firms. At this stage it looks as though we will have completed the works by summer 2025 at which point we will be able to move in for Mass.
