


What do you remember from the reading today?








How do you think that the servants must have felt when they saw that the water had turned into wine?

Why do you think he performed this miracle, turning the water into wine?


What does it tell us about him?




The miracle shows us how special and important Jesus is. It shows us that he is the Son of God and that he can do anything.

While we cannot work miracles, with our kindness, we can make real changes that make a difference to our own lives and the lives of others.




What changes do you think we can make to help build a fairer world, so that all people have what they need to live happy, healthy and peaceful lives?




It could be raising money for a charity like CAFOD which helps people who are poor around the world, or it can be by letting our leaders know that we want them to take action to protect our world or to bring peace.

We pray for people who are living in poverty throughout the world: that together with them we may never stop working for a fairer world and a future filled with hope.


