Welcome to our AGM and social evening for the school's PTFA. It's lovely to see so many of you and a huge thankyou you for coming to support us this evening, as without the AGM we would not be able to run as a PTFA.

We have had a busy and challenging year as the PTFA with lots happening throughout each term. As last year, we have tried to organise a range of events and activities throughout the year, that the children enjoy and hopefully remember. An overview of what we have achieved this past year is underneath this report - please do have a look.

We have continued to run with a team approach, rather than the traditional model of designated chair, treasurer, secretary with everyone on the team taking responsibility for the smooth running of the PTFA. So, we are voting a temporary treasurer in tonight in the hope that we will find a parent/grandparent/family member etc who would be willing to take this on in the team.

Another challenge we have faced this year, and will continue to do so is volunteers. We are building up a brilliant group of volunteers, who are not on the team, and we hope that this will continue. However, bigger events such as a Christmas fair, required a huge amount of man power and after our Christmas events we decided to change the way we plan to ensure we have the volunteers needed to hold an event. If we don't, then unfortunately, the event wont happen not only for health and safety reasons but for health and well-being reasons as well.

We'd like to take this opportunity to thank everyone who has supported us over the year. From volunteering their time to helping set up and clear up, to donating uniform, to helping man the gates at Marnhull fest.
