We are still and silent as we reflect on God's word for us in the Gospel.




What do you remember from the reading today?





Do you remember what Simon says?




He does not think they will catch anything. They haven't caught anything all night.

Have you ever been fishing? What was it like?




Chico lives in the Brazilian Amazon rainforest. He is a leader of the indigenous Tururukare community and lives beside the river.





Every week the whole village community comes together to share a meal, including the fish they have caught in the river.




Jesus tells the disciples that they will become fishers of people.

What do you think that this means?




At the end of the reading the disciples leave everything behind to follow Jesus.

From now on they will spend their time with him, sharing his message with other people.




How do you think it must have felt for the disciples to leave all their belongings and all their family and friends behind, to follow Jesus?


