

New Advance Notice: 24 Hours with the Lord: a Lenten initiative of prayer and reconciliation introduced by Pope Francis, will be celebrated in dioceses around the world. As with previous editions, the event will take place on the eve of the Fourth Sunday of Lent, from Friday 28 March to Saturday 29 March. In our parish this will take place at St Benedict's Church in Gillingham, starting with th Friday evening Mass, and then having Adoration for 24 hours, culminating with Mass on the Saturday evening. There will be opportunities for the sacrament of reconciliation. More details and a sign up sheet will be available shortly.

'Praying with the Scriptures - An interactive prayer workshop on the theme "Pilgrims of Hope" to tie in with our Jubilee Year.' Venue: Our Lady's, Marnhull. Our time together in this workshop will be practical and interactive, as well as contemplative, guided group work in helping people to pray with others. "For the Word of God is alive and active. Sharper than any double-edged sword, it penetrates even to dividing soul and spirit, joints and marrow, it judges the thoughts and attitudes of the heart. (Hebrews 4.12)".
