The Bishops' Conference of England & Wales is calling on all Catholics to unite in prayer and compassionate action to oppose assisted suicide. On Friday, 29 November, the House of Commons will hear the Second Reading of a bill on assisted suicide tabled by Labour MP Kim Leadbeater.
